



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If God is so good...

– why is there so much evil in the world?

PUT IN SHORT: Because God chose to create man with a free will..

It can be difficult to imagine an exciting or attractive world without free will in it! Without free will, we would have been robots. Free will is the foundation of love, of creativity and of many of those things that enrich your daily life the most. But at the same time, free will is also the basis of hatred and of those things that bring pain into the lives of human beings. The human will can be both a beautiful and terrifying thing. But love is such a great and wonderful thing, that God did not desire a world without the free will of man. The Bible tells us:

The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord's; But the earth he has given to the children of men. (Psalm 115:16)

God has entrusted us with the responsibility of this earth. That means that we are held accountable by the way we treat this earth and each other. This knowledge is essentially a constructive help to us. In this life, we can choose to listen to that which is either good or evil. We can impact the world in an either good or evil way! And it has an enormous importance in regard both to us and the people around us, what we choose here. When this life is over, we will all be held accountable to God. God will judge us for the evil we have done. God, who has entrusted us with this life, will hold us accountable.

Therefore, it's better if we judge ourselves now – and change our direction in life, so that we will not be judged by God someday.

How can we use our free will in the best way possible?

We do this by listening to the One who has made us. He wants us to walk in love. In this way, we are helping to make an evil world a better place. We are called to love like Jesus.

What about people who are suffering?

God is in no way indifferent to people who suffer. In fact, He cares and weeps over the suffering and oppression that people on earth go through. He wants for you and me to help ease suffering and fight injustice. Perhaps you have experienced how people have caused unjust harm in your own life? Perhaps, by what you have said or done, you have been the cause of pain in other people's lives?

The good news is, that one day, God will end all suffering for those that have received Jesus Christ as their Savior. Here we can add that little, innocent children, that die all too soon, will go directly to heaven, because Jesus said that theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Without light we will end up in darkness

It is in fellowship with God that our lives will enter that balance, which we were created for. There, righteousness, life and joy are released.

Jesus said:

I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness but have the light of life. (John 8:12)

But if we choose to turn our backs on God and His good will, then another power will have an easier access to us. This speaks about evil itself – the devil and his demons. If we do not believe that the devil exists, it will be difficult for us to understand the world we live in – and maybe also the battles that we might experience in our own souls. How can people in some cases develop such evil behavior? Why does history show us that, suddenly, cruel regimes can rise up, that create terrible concentration camps, such as those seen under Hitler or in North Korea? Yes, there is evidently an evil force working in this world that we human beings can come under the influence of.

That's why we need the same love that Jesus had – it's the only light that drives out darkness.

Will God then continue to watch, as precious people are oppressed?

No, the Bible tells us that one day Jesus will come back and end all evil on earth. He will return as the King of Kings, and every knee will bow to Him. He will make our broken

world into the most wonderful Paradise again. But first the gospel of Jesus will be proclaimed to

all nations, and people of all ethnical groups will find salvation in Jesus. Through His Son, God will prove that love is stronger than hatred, and that good can conquer evil.

God is good. He did not leave us totally to ourselves. He sent His own Son, so that through Him, we can be forgiven – and receive a second chance. A second chance where we – by His help – can conquer evil with good!

No human being has ever loved like the man Jesus of Nazareth when He was crucified...

Freely the Creator stretched out His hands towards the east and the west and called out:

Perfect love

The love of mankind, and the love of God

We all have a desire to experience true love.

Countless songs are written about the longing for love.

The love between people can be something amazing, but, unfortunately, also something quite fragile.

The love of human beings is mostly limited - i.e. limited to our family, friends or some specific people that are sympathetic or good towards us. If someone treats us poorly, we automatically draw away from them. The love of human beings is usually conditional and often quite uncertain.

God's love, on the other hand, far exceeds the love of man. It's not weak and doesn't leave people when they fail. Even though we have turned our backs on Him, He is still standing there, waiting for us.

All the truly good gifts in life come from Him. He understands you – even better than you understand yourself, and He is in fact able to satisfy your inner being more than anyone else. That is why it is so life changing to get to know HIM!

If, for some reason, you believe that you have a right to be angry with God, then it is probably because you don't know Him, or because things in your life have not been sorted properly. God is not the reason for the evil we see happening. Evil things in this world come from the

unrighteousness of men and rebellion against God, and from God's enemy, Satan. God is pure light, and no darkness is found in Him. He is perfectly righteous – and no evil can exist in His presence. God's love is extended to all people. Through Jesus, He has shown us who He really is: The One who seeks out and saves the lost! It is interesting to note that the greatest kind of love shows itself through a self-sacrificing rescue mission.

The Bible tells us: But God demonstrates His love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)


Perfect love was demonstrated to us through Jesus! The Bible tells us that Jesus loved to the very end. Even when he died on the cross He loved His enemies. When the soldiers pierced His hands and feet and nailed Him to the cross, He prayed for His executioners: "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do."

Through love toward every human being – including you and me – He freely gave His life on the cross. His love was greater than what He had to suffer! Not even torture unto death was able to stop His love.

Can God forgive me no matter what I've done?

Yes, the only sin that cannot be forgiven, is if we refuse to receive the salvation that is extended toward us through Jesus Christ.


Try to understand it this way: God has sacrificed His Son - His only Son - because of you and it is of utmost importance to God, that you thankfully receive this, His ultimate gift. Other than that, there is not really any sin that God cannot forgive.



Even if you had killed someone, and then turned to God and asked to be forgiven and have another chance, you would probably have to go to jail, but eternal life would be available through Jesus. God can forgive more than people can.

I can personally confirm how God's love can flow through us and release us from guilt and fear. I am overwhelmed at the number of times I have gotten to experience God's liberating and wonderful presence. All we need to do is to show the greatest kind of respect to Him and to His word.

Being the object of God's infinite love is not limited according to what we deserve. It is what the Bible calls grace. God's grace means that we can be forgiven and become the children of God without deserving it.



What do I need Jesus for?

Maybe you have had one of the following thoughts?

- If God is truly there, how can I get in contact with Him?
- I can believe in God, but what do I need Jesus for?

According to the Bible, in the beginning there was a perfect harmony between God and man. In God's eyes, man was the best thing He had created. Because God had made man in His own image, man had a very special relationship with God.

In the garden, all life was in perfect balance – the kind of harmony we might all be longing for. Back then, there was no cold wind, nor any grey hairs or any dead thing. Everything was happy and harmonious - and it wasn't due to anti-depressants. But when man was tempted to go against the guidelines of God, a painful distance arose between God and man. Sin and death came into the world, which is why the world is not perfect today.

The fall in the garden was tragic, but in time, man began to seek God – despite the distance that had now been created. God chose a people among those who sought Him, and He gave them the Ten Commandments among other things. You know, those saying:

You may not kill, you may not steal, you may not lie, and so on. They speak about God's righteousness, and God is far more just and perfect than we can understand.

Jesus stood forth as the only perfect person on earth – and showed us God's heart. He spoke the truth in love and healed people everywhere He went. The Bible tells us that Jesus is the express image of God. That means, that if we want to know who God is, we need to look at Jesus.

Jesus explained that all people will be held accountable for their lives, and that after this life, there awaits us either a wonderful heaven or a terrible hell. Today, this is confirmed through thousands of near-death experiences. So, you see, you and I will be judged when this life is over. And the way that we will be judged, will not be according to the standards of men, but the standard of God.

It is in fact a logical thing:

If heaven needs to be perfect, then no sin nor evil can be allowed to enter heaven.

To be able to save us, Jesus had to make us realize just how serious a thing our sin is. Not according to the standards of men, but in fact, according to the standard of heaven.

In God's court of law

Several places in the Bible, we read that no liars, thieves, deceivers, scoffers nor sexually immoral people will enter heaven. Some will object here and say: "But I'm a good person." But with the self-righteous

people, Jesus simply tightens the rules, and says: "But whoever says, 'You fool!' shall be in danger of hell fire." (Matt. 5:22)

Let's be honest: Have you ever lied? Or stolen something? Have you always honored God? Have you hurt someone, or have you been part of bullying someone? Have you been selfish at the expense of others?

- In all honesty, I just lost the opportunity to make it to heaven on my own here. What about you?

BUT, - it is right here, when you really understand that you stand guilty before God, that you see your need for mercy and forgiveness. And right here, you can come to appreciate what Jesus has done for you!.

The Bible tells us this about Jesus:

He himself bore our sins in His body on the cross \dots

(1. Peter 2:24; NIV)

He who was innocent, yes, completely blameless, took upon Himself your sin and my sin. And in that same moment, the veil to the holiest room inside of the temple was torn in two, because Jesus had made a way for us to fellowship with God. On the third day, Jesus rose from the dead, and thereby conquered the power of death. After His resurrection, at least 500 people saw Him – before He was visibly carried off to heaven.

Your salvation has been paid for, but you need to receive it — by letting Jesus become your Savior. This naturally means that He then also becomes your Lord — that means the highest authority in your life. Being completely submitted to Jesus is part of "the narrow way" that leads to EVERLASTING LIFE! (Matt. 7:13-14; Luke 6:46-49).

On the cross, Jesus has purchased your freedom with His blood. He has opened a way unto eternal life for you! And if you say yes to Him, you no longer belong to yourself. Instead, you now belong to Him, The One who has conquered death.

If you say no to Him, you will be judged for your sins. In that case, the devil will have a claim on you, and you will end up in hell.

Jesus said about Himself:

I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. (John 14:6)

That is why you will not be able to know God, without first relating to Jesus.

When Jesus died on the cross, it was the greatest act of love in world history. Jesus entered the deepest darkness for you, for me and for all people – to save as many as possible. This powerful message can fill any heart with peace.

The choice is yours: Are you willing to risk dying – without knowing Jesus?

When you die, it will be to late to decide. An example of this is: If you're flying from Copenhagen to New York tonight, you need to redeem your ticket and board the plane. Otherwise, the plane will leave without you. Not choosing is also a choice.

Therefore: When God shows you that you need to make a choice – it's time to choose.


Jesus said:

The one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out. (John 6:37)

What do I need to do? Specific steps?

- Admit to God that you have sinned and ask for His forgiveness in Jesus' name. Name the things that you regret. Call on Jesus and ask for a completely new start in life! The Bible says: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1. John 1:9).
- Turn away from all sin and let Jesus become Lord of your life! Decide that from now on His word will be the highest authority in your life.
- Be baptized in water like Jesus said. Water baptism is a burial of the old, sinful life and a resurrection into the new life with Jesus. Read Romans 6:3-5. (We can help you to get baptized or to find someone near you that can help you).
- Receive the Holy Spirit God's tangible presence. This is also called the baptism of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit gives you the power to live the new life as a disciple of Jesus. When you are filled with the Holy Spirit, you can experience a new freedom, speaking in tongues and other gifts of the Spirit. You can read about it in The Book of Acts, chap. 8, 10 and 19. Also, look up The Gospel of John chap. 7:38-39.
- Read the Bible / The New Testament daily! The Bible is filled with life-giving words for you. It is your spiritual food.
- Pray and say thank you. Set aside a good amount of time to fellowship with God in prayer each day! Prayer is like breath to the believer.
- Find a fellowship of Christians that truly live with God. In time, God will reward you with the best kind of fellowship you have ever experienced.
- Share your faith with others!

The best thing that has happened in my life

The best thing, that has happened to me, was God meeting me with His presence and freedom. It was completely life changing for me to go from a theoretical faith to a personal experience with the Holy Spirit. This has had consequences that stretch far and wide in a wonderful way!

I already understood the theory that Jesus died for our sin, so that we can be forgiven when we sincerely turn to Him. But the actual reality that we find in the Bible, I never imagined that I would be able to experience. That is, that God sets us free, and wants to lead us and use us...

I struggled with fear in high school, and several times, I skipped school because of the fear of having to speak in front of others. The fear of losing control of my speech and breathing, and the fear of being ridiculed. I struggled with great performance anxiety – and generally feared what other people thought of me.

When I joined the military after high school, I was afraid to tell anyone that I came in a Christian Bible study group. The group invited me to a meeting in Markuskirken (the name of a Danish state church) in Aalborg, where the priest invited different free church Christians to come and speak. When I came to the meeting and heard the Norwegian evangelist, Aril Edvardsen, speak, I experienced something totally new – the presence of God!

I received a book called "Kampen mod Goliat" (English: The Fight Against Goliath), which described Aril Edvardsens personal struggles against all that fear, that hinder so many people in living out the possibilities that God has in fact prepared for us. The book vividly describes how, with the help of God, he has overcome fear again and again. I ate every word – and it produced faith in me.

Something completely new started to happen on the inside of me - and for 14 days in a row, two new thoughts, that I had never thought before, kept appearing. The one thought was: "Maybe I have completely put a limit on what God can do in my life!?" And the other thought was: "Lars, for every area of your life that you surrender to Jesus, you will be a thousand times happier, than keeping it to yourself..."

After this I one night experienced waking up three times in a very special way, where I heard a physically audible voice repeating the sentence: "God receives a new generation."

I normally sleep like a rock, but here I woke up immediately, like turning on a light switch. I then fell asleep again, just like turning off that same light switch. This happened at both 1 o'clock, 2 o'clock, and 3 o'clock in the night, and each time with the same message.

The next morning, I felt how everything had changed in me - I had been marked for life. I had had an experience that I thought was impossible. After this, every night, I was completely absorbed with the Bible instead of watching television. And for the next two months, every day I experienced the wonderful and liberating presence of God. Tears would stream down my face as I read the Bible, listened to Christian music, or secretly bowed my knees before God.

In this period, I really got to see firsthand how God can be experienced, like an embrace of love that liberates. I read that Jesus set

people free from sickness and evil powers – and one night, suddenly, I said: "Fear, let go of me, in Jesus' mighty name!" And it worked! From the moment I had commanded the fear to leave in Jesus' name, suddenly, I was able to do all those things that I couldn't do before! For the first time since childhood, I could just be myself and stand up in gatherings and speak without the least bit of fear – in a fully relaxed and natural way. I had really gotten a breakthrough, and suddenly, there was nothing more attractive to me than to ask God to begin to show me the wonderful plans He had for my life.


Through 22 years, I've now had a continual "wellspring of gratitude" to God on the inside, thankful for His freedom from things that bind, from lies and limitations.

Jesus said: And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall set you free. (John 8:32)

I've experienced this! There can be things that hinder the truth from breaking through, but when it finally does break through, the word and the Spirit of God will set us free.

Even though I had grown up in the faith, I had no idea that God is in fact able to interactively work in our lives, and God will open the door for the most exciting and meaningful opportunities when we give full control to Him. The combination of His freeing presence, the living Word of the Bible and what I could see in people who had a strong walk with God, gave me the faith and trust to wholeheartedly surrender all areas of my life to Jesus!

This is the best thing that has happened in my life..





What is a Christian?

The Bible gives us these answers:

- Someone who believes that Jesus is the Son of God, who took the punishment for all our sins on the cross on our behalf! (John 20:31, 1. Cor.15:3 og 1.Pet.2:24)
- 2) Someone who has fellowship with Jesus and with others who believe in Him! (John 15:4-6, 1. Cor. 1:9 and 1. John 1:3-7)
- Someone who lives in the light of what Jesus has said, and who has decided that HE and His word is the highest authority in that person's life! (Luke 6:46-49, John 8:31-32 and John 14:23)
- 4) Someone who has been saved from the power of sin and Satan and has been transferred into the kingdom of light! (John 8:24, Acts 26:18, and Col. 1:13-14)
- Someone who lives in daily and personal repentance and considers God's will to be more important than his/her own. (Luke 9:23, Mark 3:35 and 1. John 2:17)
- 6) Someone who, through sincere faith in Jesus, has become a child of God and has received eternal life as a gift! (John 1:12 + 3:15-16, Rom.6:23 og 1. John 5:13)
- 7) Someone who surrenders to God and is now able to experience the help and guidance of God in all areas of life! (Ps. 37:5, Matt. 6:9-10, Matt. 6:33 and Rom. 12:2)

- 8) Someone who does not have to fear death! (Luke 12:47, John 5:24 and Hebr. 2:14-15)
- 9) Someone who is never alone, but who experiences the presence of God through the Holy Spirit! (Matt. 28:20, John 7:37-39, John 14:16-23 and Acts 2:38)
- 10) Someone who is now able to experience the greatest meaning in life possible! (Eph. 2:10, Acts 1:8, John 10:10 and Dan. 12:3)
- 11) Someone who is happy to be forgiven and is willing to forgive others! (Matt. 6:12-15 and Matt. 18:21-35)
- 12) Someone who, throughout life, learns to love and to serve, and who learns to long for God's approval rather than the approval of people!

 (John 13:34, Mark 10:43-45, John 5:44 and 1. Thess. 3:12)
- 13) Someone who does not serve in his own power, but who is depending on The One who strengthens us by His word and Spirit. (John 15:1-8, Rom. 8:26-29 and Hebr. 13:20-21)
- 14) Someone who does not accept sin and selfishness in his/her own life! (Luke 15:10, Rom. chapter 6, Gal. 5:13-25 and Eph. 4:17-5:11)
- 15) Someone who gratefully desires to live their life in honor of Jesus! (Luke 19:1-10, Gal. 2:20, Ps. 119:32 and 1. Tim. 1:12-17)



Eternal life in heaven

DOES A GREATER HOPE THAN THIS EXIST... in a world filled with distress and pain? Unfortunately, this world is filled with broken friendships, marriages and agreements. It hurts us when the trust is broken, or when we lose someone that we care for.

Does an eternal life without this pain exist?

We hope that we will meet people who we have lost, again. We have a longing for something more, something better. Where does this longing come from? The Bible says that God "put eternity in our hearts" (Eccl. 3:11). The more you sincerely seek for these things, the clearer this becomes to you. Heaven is a reality!

How can I become more certain about the reality of heaven?

The internet is in fact full of stories of near-death experiences and with presently living people's experiences with heaven. People who have been dead and experienced heaven, describe heaven as being much more real than this world.

God can place a deep certainty about heaven into your life. This certainty comes from walking with Jesus. Shortly before she died, my grandmother said that she looked forward to coming home to Jesus and to Ernst (her husband who died first). She said this with joy and great peace in her eyes!

My grandmother has told me, that when my great grandfather died, a great light entered the room, and that he died with the happiest smile on his face. Someone in the room said: "Now it's evident that Jesus is coming to get him." Two family members both expressed

how this was the strongest moment in their lives – seeing my great grandfather die! My great grandfather had been a burning Christian.

To be born again

Human beings consist of spirit, soul and body. But many look past the fact that they have a spirit, and that because of this, they have spiritual needs. At the creation in Paradise, man had a dimension of spiritual life that we lost in the fall. The loss of the spiritual life was tragic, because death came into the world, and we lost the presence of God. Heaven was in a way pulled out of our hearts – and left an empty space in us.

We are in fact designed to be able to register the reality of the kingdom of God while we are here on earth. But this ability was lost to begin with.

That is why Jesus explains:

Unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. (John 3:3)

This means that we have a basic need that needs to be met, in order for us to see the kingdom of God. Jesus says, that we need to be born again.

Remove the barrier

In His wisdom and love, God has created all of us, but we have all turned our backs on Him with our choices and actions. Sin unfortunately brings us at a distance of God. If we do not know what our problem is, how can we then value its cure? If you have been bitten by a deadly venomous snake, you will want the antidote.

AT THE MOMENT when you understand that your sin is as deadly poison, you can come to Jesus – and receive the antidote. "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1. John 1:9). God always keeps His promises.

The barrier will be removed, and God's Spirit will flow into your inner being, so that you can begin to see the kingdom of God and understand how He works. Sincere repentance unto Jesus makes us become spiritually alive, and that is the greatest and most important miracle a person can experience in this lifetime!

Jesus also warned!

The Bible does not only speak about heaven, but also about hell. Therefore, it was also part of Jesus' message to warn us. Here's an example of what He said: "And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell" (Matt. 10:28). Here, Jesus is saying that we need to have a serious respect for God.

At the end of this life, there are only two possible places to go, namely heaven or hell. The Bible describes hell as a place of torment, as a lake of fire, and as a place "prepared for the devil and his angels" (Matt. 25:41). Hell is not a place that God wants people to go. But He will not save those that are not willing to grab a hold of the lifebelt.

There are people that experience life on earth as an extremely painful thing. I know someone who suffered from depression for seven years. Today he is well. But how terribly awful would it not be to have to suffer forever!?

Heaven, on the other hand, is far more wonderful than we can imagine. There is no fear, loneliness or pain there. Going to heaven will be like coming home! There, we will be completely freed from everything that has made our lives difficult. He will wipe every tear from our eyes, and we will rejoice with an inexpressible joy, the Bible tells us. It will also be a place of meeting for everyone who, throughout the ages, have received the salvation of God. That is why, in His great love, God is also calling you today.

The Lord... is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance. (2.Pet.3:9; NIV)

God loves people, and sincerely desires for people to come to repentance. Satan, on the other hand, hates us and wants to deceive us. There is a spiritual battle going on for your soul. "Satan," which means "God's adversary," tries to plant his rebellion against God on the inside of people. Right from the beginning, he tempted man to doubt the good guidelines that God laid out for them, and since then, he has been working behind the scenes to affect and destroy people.

But the amazing thing is, that if you cling to what Jesus has done for you on the cross and put His word above your life, the devil has no power over you. Jesus has paid for you with His blood on the cross, and neither death nor the devil can do anything against this.

A vision from God

One day God gave me a vision that deeply moved me: In this vision, I saw that when Jesus completed His suffering on the cross, it released a kind of inexpressible joy. It seemed as if though millions of angels and people were shouting with great joy. In every single soul there, there was a place of deep joy wherefrom that joy sprang forth like a fountain - it was the most real and unrestrained kind of joy imaginable!

I look forward to experience this kind of joy in heaven – but the incredible thing about it is that we can have a foretaste of it already here on earth.

Turn to God by receiving Jesus as your Savior and Lord!

The Bible – about heaven

After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" All the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, saying:

"Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom, Thanksgiving and honor and power and might, Be to our God for ever and ever.

Amen."

Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?" And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. Therefore they are before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them. They shall neither hunger anymore nor thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any heat; for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of water. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes." (Rev. 7:9-17)



A life filled with faith, hope and meaning

Life with God is anything but boring! The Christian life that Jesus launched was a real adventure! God challenges us to live completely with HIM, to dare things, to dare to put our trust in His word.

I am one of those people who have tested to see if the promises of God hold. After 22 years of daily company with Him - I can tell you that the promises hold. When you surrender completely to Jesus, the kingdom of God enters your life in a special way. This has changed my life completely.

I have seen countless healings in the name of Jesus. I personally know a Danish man who died from a tropical disease, but who was brought back to life by prayer in the name of Jesus. I have experienced financial miracles, I have seen a deaf man being healed on the open streets of Aalborg, and I have seen people's lives being completely transformed.

But these amazing things are not the things that are the greatest to me. To me, the greatest thing is the peace and liberation that Jesus has brought into my inner being. And it is out of gratitude toward Him that I want to make Him known!

It is so amazing to find out that the God of the Bible is the true God. You don't have to search through all the alternative religions of the world – there is no faith, that delivers so many clear evidences (through the experiences of people) as the Christian faith does! I want to tell you, that what you need is Jesus! He is the way, the truth and the life. Don't take a detour – *turn to God!*
